The temporary position is for 30 hours per week for ten weeks, from June 13th – August 18th with flexibility to work some Saturdays. Students enrolled in education, childcare or recreation courses will find the position a rewarding learning experience. The position is supported through funding by the Canada Summer Jobs program.

Salary: \$17.55 per hour.

Deadline for application: Saturday April 8th, 2017. Interviews will take place April 12th and 13th. Submit cover letter and resume to sophie.gawn@secheltlibrary.ca

Duties: Assists children's services staff prepare, promote and present the Summer Reading Club program and activities for children ages 5 –10; plan and supervise a teen book club for ages 11-15; and coordinate a Reading Buddies program.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be between the ages of 15 and 30 and have been registered as full-time students in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year, be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*; and, be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations

Previous experience working with children and good organizational skills are necessary. Familiarity with the library environment and knowledge of children's books and reading would be an asset.
