

# AUDIOBOOKS ON MP3'S

How to download audiobooks on to your iPod or MP3 player

## HOW TO INSTALL OVERDRIVE

### Apple Devices

1. Go to [app.overdrive.com](http://app.overdrive.com)
2. Click **Download on the App Store**
3. **Run** or **Open** the MSI file to open the setup wizard
4. When the setup wizard opens, follow the prompts to install OverDrive

### PC Devices

1. Go to [app.overdrive.com](http://app.overdrive.com)
2. Click **Get It On Google Play**
3. **Run** or **Open** the MSI file to open the setup wizard
4. When the setup wizard opens, follow the prompts to install OverDrive

## HOW TO SIGN IN TO OVERDRIVE

1. Open the Overdrive app on your computer
2. Click **Have an Account? Sign In**
3. Click **Sign In Using Library Card**
4. Choose **Sechelt Public Library**
5. Enter your library barcode with no spaces and your pin. Your pin is the last 4 numbers of your phone number unless you've changed it.

## HOW TO DOWNLOAD AN AUDIOBOOK

1. Visit <https://bcpl.overdrive.com/bcpl-sechelt/content> or click **+ Add a Title** in the Overdrive app to find available audiobooks at Sechelt Library
2. Click **Borrow** on the audiobook you would like to listen to
3. Select Sechelt Public Library
4. Enter your library barcode with no spaces and your pin. Your pin is the last 4 numbers of your phone number unless you've changed it.
5. Choose to borrow for 7, 14, or 21 days
6. Click **Borrow**
7. Click **Download MP3 Audiobook**
8. Click **Confirm**
9. Click on the downloaded file to open it in the Overdrive app

## HOW TO PLACE A HOLD

1. If the item is currently checked out, you will not see a **Borrow** button on the item. Instead you will click on **Place a Hold**.
2. Enter your email address twice
3. Click **Place a Hold**
4. An email will be sent to your when the hold is ready

## HOW TO TRANSFER AUDIOBOOKS TO AN MP3

1. Plug your iPod or MP3 player into your computer using a Micro USB cable
2. Click on the **audiobook you want to transfer**
3. Click **Transfer** in the top right corner
4. Follow the on-screen prompts to transfer the audiobook to your device.
4. Once it's transferred, you can listen to it just like any other audio file on your device.

*Note: On iPods, you can find transferred audiobooks under "Music."*
