## 5. STEAM kits

STEAM = Science, technology, engineering, art and math. \$3600 of our technology grant is going towards the first 24 STEAM kits. So far, 24 kits have been fully developed, 10 have been fully catalogued and we are aiming for two additional catalogues a week. These are a hot ticket on the wait list! We also received a donation for \$100 which was specifically requested towards music – which means that we can purchase a ukulele and music for another STEAM kit.

## 6. Spring Break Programs

Our Technology Coordinator and Adult Programmer teamed up to pull together an incredible Spring Break Program for children. We will be advertising in the newspaper early March.
