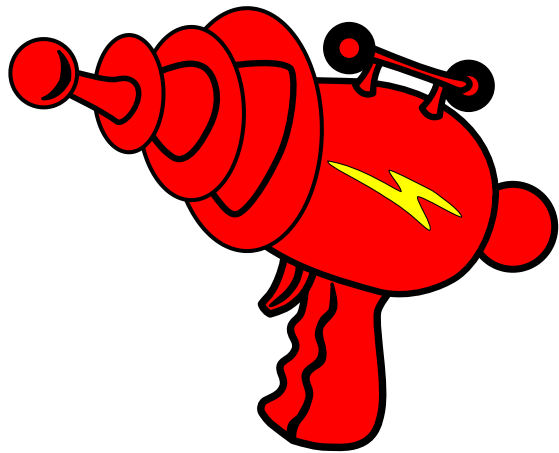
**Laser Tag at the Library!**
